The Rapid Re-Housing (RRH) Advocate is responsible for providing advocacy and support to victims and survivors of domestic violence who are experiencing homelessness. The RRH Advocate helps to connect survivors to housing resources using a combination of New Hope funding and other community vouchers. This position also assists in staffing our helpline. It is based in either our Bath or Rockland office and requires traveling throughout our catchment area.

- Knowledge of local social services, housing, criminal justice, education, and health systems
- Organized, with strong attention to detail and a structured way of approaching tasks
